

### Literacy

- Children to work through a range of genres – focusing on British Literacy and develop speaking skills, through reciting poetry, reading & drama.
- Fiction – Science fiction exploring classical and contemporary works to identify features and inspire their own work..
- Non Fiction – Report writing and recounts based around trip to London
- Poetry – Exploring a range of poetry to develop use of descriptive phrases
- Spelling – -tious/-cious and -ent/-ant words, silent letter words,

### Maths

- Examples of activities the children will work on:
- Properties of shape- explore and identify properties of different triangles and quadrilaterals. To identify regular and irregular polygons
- Geometry – Identify angles at a point, at one whole turn, on a straight line & half a turn, be able to distinguish between regular & irregular polygons, investigate rotation, reflection & translation using coordinates in two quadrants

### Science

- We will revisit forces, identifying forces on a stationary and moving object.
- Design an experiment to protect an egg when falling

### Visits and Visitors

- Visit to London – London Museum, Science Museum, performance of Charlie and the Chocolate Factory

### Enrichment and Experiences

- Children to perform their KS2 Spring production

### History

- Linked to the school trip – children will learn about the history of London and how it has changed over time.

### Geography - London

- Linked to the school trip – children will learn about the importance of the capital city and its impact on the country. They will learn how its geographical features shaped how the city developed.



An overview of the activities and experiences the children will be covering as part of this topic.

### Art

- There is no art focus for this half term

### D.T. – 3D modelling

- Children will continue to create 3D models of famous London landmarks. They will learn to measure, mark, cut out and assemble materials to create 3D structures.

### Modern Foreign Languages

- Children will be taught French by Madame Leze each week, through practical activities & speaking & listening.
- Children will work on Salut, Gustave unit of Rigolo 2 – focusing on greeting people & being able to offer personal information eg: family, what people are like.

### PSHE – Go Givers and SEAL

- Children to understand the importance of allowing equal opportunities for all & look at groups which may be discriminated against.
- Children to look at the life of Mary Seacole & Florence Nightingale, their nursing roles & prejudices they faced.

### Computing – Programming and coding

- Children will use Scratch to create computer games. They will learn to use code to create scripts and to reason logically in order to create the desired effect.
- Children will learn to adapt and debug simple programs.

### R.E. – Christianity

- Children to learn about the significance of a Christian church, why it is an important place of worship & question why Christians need a Church to support belief.
- Children to learn about the significance of the Easter story, including the Last Supper and the Crucifixion.

### Music – Singing an performing

- Children will be learning and practicing songs for the KS2 production. They will develop their singing and performance skills

### P.E. – Swimming, Gymnastics, KS2 Games

- Swimming – focus on refining key strokes, assessing performances & water safety skills.
- KS2 Games – focus on development of key ball control & team skills in Football, Rugby, Netball and Hockey.
- Gymnastics - skills linked to Bridges, Spinning & Turning.
