This Week: Summer 1, April 18th 2017 Teacher: Mrs Ovel

We have had a wonderful start to this new term! The children have been very happy to be back and their behaviour has been brilliant.

We have practised counting backwards and forwards to 20, counting actions and finding 1 less. You can help at home by counting small objects, getting your child to count body movements like claps and finding 1 less of an amount.

As our learning is going to focus on nature this term, we have started the by reading Stanley's Stick. We have had lots of discussions about what we would do with a favourite stick and have gone into the woods to search for our own favourite sticks.

In phonics, we are practising a lot of new phonemes (sounds) which are linked to your child's reading books. Can I please ask that you read with your child at least three times a week? It can be a couple of pages or more. After your child has read their book twice, either at home or at school, it will be changed.

On Wednesday all Reception parents are invited to our maths café. This will be at 9:00 to approximately 9:30 in the school hall. Counting is the focus and we will be showing you lots of activities that you can do at home.
