Sports Enrichment Week—Reminder

We have been able to plan some exciting activities for all of the children as part of our Sports Enrichment Week beginning on Monday 24th June 2024, coinciding with Sports Day on Tuesday 25th June.

Pupils across the school will experience several sporting and outdoor activities across the week. We have booked some external venues, but will also be receiving visitors into school to allow the pupils to experience and practise new sporting techniques with professional instructors. Your child will experience a range (but not all) of the following activities:
